Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope this finds you well and that you are looking forward to the break of the school routine next week.

We would like to start by thanking you for a hugely successful term. It can sometimes be forgotten that the beginning of this term was the reopening of our school after five and a half months. From the outset we have been hugely impressed with our students' approach, maturity and resilience. They are to be commended on adapting to the school site, re-engaging with their learning and working together as a community.

We have also been impressed with the students' approach to wearing masks. The expectation is for all students to wear masks in all communal areas. We are not in the position to continue to hand out disposable masks after half term and we ask that all students are reminded to bring their mask every day. If a student does not have a mask we will make contact with home to arrange to bring one in.

If your daughter travels on school transport you will have received communication regarding the expectation to wear masks. We expect our students, when in the community, to represent the school in an appropriate way, following all social distancing guidelines.

Students are expected to be in full school uniform when in school. This includes blazers. We will continue to ask students to come into school in the appropriate uniform and will be focusing on this next term. During the first week our focus will be on PE uniform and we ask you to note the following:

Jumpers- These should be plain black, grey or navy without a hood. Zip up tops without a hood are also fine as long as they are black, grey or navy. It is preferable that pupils wear the school logo jackets/ rugby tops but we know some (especially year 11) have either lost or outgrown these.

Bottoms- Either the school skirts or black/navy tracksuit bottoms. This also includes sports leggings that should be plain black but not normal leggings.

Students who do not wear the correct PE uniform will be asked to correct this.

We understand that the weather will become colder after half term and students may wish to wear additional layers. Our expectations are that layers can be worn underneath uniform and the only additional outer layer is a coat.

The following are not permitted in school:

- Hoodies
- Additional jumpers
- Leggings
- Scarves
- Hats

We would be very grateful for your support of our uniform expectations

At the time of writing this the normal half term will run. If anything changes we will communicate with you via email and our Twitter page.

We hope you and your families have restful half term.
